
Students have been running hard all week long - One more week to go! The goal of this school wide initiative is to encourage fitness, get active and build stamina over the two week period with running!

## This Week in Mrs. Brunn's Class - Grade 1




It has been an exciting week in our classroom! We recently explored the life cycle of ladybugs, observing them closely as they grew and changed right in our classroom. After the ladybugs emerged from their pupae, we were able to release them into nature.





This week we went on a field trip to Mission Creek Park, where we participated in a pond study. At the pond, we looked closely at the water, searching for insects and other small creatures.

In writing, students have begun working on their very own nonfiction animal reports! Each child has chosen an animal they're curious about and have been busy researching interesting facts about their animal's body, food, and habitat. Be sure to ask your child something new they've learned — you might be surprised by their amazing facts!



We've also been learning about how to give and receive **helpful feedback**. After watching *Austin's Butterfly*, students practiced drawing their chosen animal and then shared kind, specific feedback with one another to help improve their illustrations. It's been wonderful to see them improve on their work and grow as artists and learners!

In math, we are continuing our **learning on Canadian coins**, focusing on recognizing and counting the same denomination. Students have been participating in fun math games to strengthen their skills and build their

confidence with coins.
